

## Be prepared!

- Know if the school has participated in the IYS in the past. Check which other schools in the area are participating.
- Determine who would be the best person at the school to discuss IYS. Seek other community and school supports to encourage school personnel's interest.
- Understand and be comfortable discussing the benefits of IYS participation with the school.
- Download documents to share with school personnel from the IYS website.
- Stay current on IYS news by checking announcements on the IYS website, visiting the IYS Facebook page, and joining the IYS email list.
- After reviewing the website, contact the IYS coordinator with any remaining questions or concerns.
- Be ready to share specific tasks you will do to support the school's participation (e.g. registering the school, assisting with survey administration).
